Congregation Briefed

At the Annual Meeting on June 9, the Building Project Task Force presented an update on events since January.

FINANCIAL STATUS GOOD:



We received bank approval for the eventual bridge loan (to cover construction costs incurred before the end of the pledge period). Meanwhile, early payment of pledges means we earn more interest while waiting for construction and will have lower financing costs. As of end-May, 75% of pledges have been fulfilled!

GAP STRATEGY BEING IMPLEMENTED:



Early fund-raising activities have helped build engagement. A variety of volunteer initiatives and net pledge increases have raised over \$20K to help fill the \$200K gap between projected pledge receipts and estimated construction costs. More activities are in the mill; stay tuned!

NEW BUILDING—NEW DATES:



Due to slow Town processing, the soonest we can now hope to break ground for the new building is in the fall. But that gives us the summer to focus on....

FIX-UP OF JONES BUILDING SPACES:



This "Phase I" project is roaring ahead. After the first two weeks of signups, 22% of the available slots in two-hour shifts throughout July - August are filled. All are encouraged to participate in a cleaning/patching/painting session or to help by coordinating a shift or two.
