## Cable



Size 7 needles. Acrylic worsted (#4) yarn – works well with Caron One Pound solid colors.

Finished size should be 7" wide x 9" tall.

Cast on 36 stitches. Be sure to leave an 18" tail at the beginning.

\*K1 P1\* repeat between \* to the end of the row (first seed stitch row).

\*P1 K1\* repeat between \* to the end of the row (second seed stitch row).

\*K1 P1\* repeat between \* to the end of the row (third seed stitch row).

## Pattern set

Row 1, 3, 5, 7: P1, K1, P11, K2, P6, K2, P12, K1 (wrong side)

Row 2: K1, P1, K11, P2, K6, P2, K12, P1

Row 4: K1, P1, K11, P2. Slip next 3 stitches onto a cable needle and hold it back of the work. K3, then K3 from the cable needle. P2, K12, P1

Row 6, 8: Same as Row 2.

STOP! Check the width to make sure it is 7". If not, start over with an appropriate number of stitches by adding or subtracting from the stockinette stitches inside the seed stitches at the beginning and end of each row or change needle size.

Repeat rows 1-8 until 6 patterns sets have been completed. If adding a complete pattern set will exceed 9" when 2-3 seed stitch rows are added, then stop when an appropriate length has been reached (~8.75"). Add 2 or 3 seed stitch rows to achieve 9", binding off in seed stitch on the wrong side. (The example in the picture had 2 seed stitch rows at the end.)

Be sure to leave an 18" tail at the end.

Now, knit another one since having two blocks in the same color and pattern is great for making shawls!
