



## **Becky's CROCHET TEDDY**



(Adapted from bevscountrycottage.com "Pair-bear" knit bear pattern)
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SC - Single Crochet
SL ST - Slip Stitch
CH - Chain
I used a size F hook with worsted
weight yarn. I crochet very loosely
therefore I would suggest a size G

weight yarn. I crochet very loosely; therefore I would suggest a size G hook if your gauge normally matches a pattern gauge. Finished Teddy should be approx. 8" tall.

LEGS Chain 8 SC in each stitch across (7 SC) for a total of 8 rows. End off and make another leg to match. Do not end off. Position legs side by side and crochet across top of both to join (14 SC).

**BODY** Work 6 rows for body.

<u>ARMS</u> At end of 6<sup>th</sup> body row, chain 7. Turn and SC in each chain and SC across. Chain 7 more for the other arm. Turn and work across. SC a total of 5 rows. Do not CH 1. Turn.

HEAD (s) SL ST across 7 SC. CH 1. SC in same space and next 13 SC. CH 1, turn and work 20 rows for head front and back.

SECOND SET OF ARMS Chain 7. Turn and SC in each chain and SC across. Chain 7 more for the other arm. Turn and work across. SC a total of 5 rows. Do not CH 1. Turn. SL ST across 7 SC. CH 1. SC in same space and next 13 SC. CH 1, turn and work 6 rows for second body piece.

SECOND SET OF LEGS CH 1, turn. SC in same space as CH 1 and next 6 SC. CH 1, turn. Work a total of 8 rows. End off. Attach yarn at other side of body and work second leg as first. End off.

Fold body in half, matching up arms and legs. Sew or crochet around, leaving opening for stuffing. Turn right side out. Stuff, then whipstitch opening closed. Tie ribbon or length of yern around neck, drawing up tightly and knotting 3 times securely. Tie ends into bow. Embroider eyes, nose and mouth in colors of your choice.

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
