

Lower Level Highlights

New “Living Room” will meet the requirement for middle school and high school youth group space on Sundays, and for casual adult meetings the rest of the week.

- This room will have lots of storage space and a small convenience counter with sink.
- The Living Room’s ceiling will be higher than the older part of the lower level, thanks to a lower floor.
- The hallway leading to the Living Room entrance will therefore be slightly ramped down from the new Lift which provides accessibility to all levels of the building.

Two new gender-neutral, family-friendly bathrooms will be large enough for accessibility by wheelchair or electric scooter.

The old bathroom plumbing will be removed (it’s on its last legs), and that area will be left empty for bulk storage.

The 3 original rooms opening to the playground will be fixed up by parent-led, volunteer beautification teams, and will be furnished for use by younger children.

Both original staircases will remain, on either side of the stage, and there will be a wider, modern staircase in the new building.

A passageway will be constructed between the old building and the new building, in the area presently occupied by the tenant preschool’s kitchen (which they will empty when they move, in May).
