

Upper and Ground Level Highlights

New “Multipurpose Room” will meet the requirement for children’s worship on Sundays, for Rites of Passage too small for the Sanctuary, for community meetings, and for other adult gatherings of up to 60 people—about half the size of the Community Room but significantly larger than our other meeting rooms.

- This room will have storage space for its own furniture, and an auxiliary room for audio-visual equipment.
- It will have ample daylighting without full window-walls, thanks to the incorporation of clerestory windows across the roofline.
- It will step down to a “gallery” (wide, windowed hallway) beyond which is a ground-level porch viewing the lawn behind the kitchen, and giving direct, covered access to a utility storage space.
- It will also have easy entrance to/from the lift which offers accessibility to all levels.

Two gender-neutral, family-friendly bathrooms, large enough for use by wheelchair or electric scooter, will be directly accessible to the Community Room on the ground level, via its open (no doors) connection to the Gallery.

The Kirby Room plus 3 smaller rooms on the upper (stage) level will be used for children’s RE programming on Sundays, and will be furnished for flexible use as adult meeting rooms the rest of the week. The 4th smaller room will become the passageway-with-storage space connecting the stage to the Multi-Purpose Room.
