Double Hearts (pointed outwards) with seed stitch edges


Size 7 needles. Acrylic worsted (\#4) yarn - works well with Caron One Pound solid colors.
Finished size should be 7" wide $\times 9^{\prime \prime}$ tall.

Cast on 31 stitches. Be sure to leave an 18 " tail at the beginning.
Rows 1 \& 2: K1 *P1 K1* repeat between * to end
Rows 3, 5: K1, P1, K27, P1, K1
Rows 4, 6: K1, P29, K1
STOP! Check the width to make sure it is 7 ". If not, start over with an appropriate number of stitches by adjusting the number of stitches just inside the seed stitch border at the beginning and end of each row.

Row 7: K1, P1, K13, P1, K13, P1, K1
Row 8: K1, P14, K1, P14, K1
Row 9: K1, P1, K12, P1, K1, P1, K12, P1, K1
Row 10: K1, P13, K1, P1, K1, P13, K1
Row 11: K1, P1, K11, P1, K3, P1, K11, P1, K1

STOP! You have completed half of the rows in the block pattern. Check the length to make sure it will not exceed 9". Adjust the final length by reducing Rows 29-32 in pairs, e.g. eliminate Row 31 and 32 then follow Rows 33 to the end or add rows in pairs before Row 33 to add length.

Row 30: K1, P29, K1
Row 31: K1, P1, K27, P1, K1
Row 32: K1, P29, K1
Row 33: K1, P1, K9, P2, K5, P2, K9, P1, K1
Row 34: K1, P10, K2, P5, K2, P10, K1
Row 35: K1, P1, K8, P1, K2, P1, K3, P1, K2, P1, K8, P1, K1
Row 36: K1, P9, K1, P2, K1, P3, K1, P2, K1, P9, K1

Row 57 \& 58: K1 *P1 K1* repeat between * to end. Bind off in row 58.

Be sure to leave an $18^{\prime \prime}$ tail at the end.
Now, knit another one since having two blocks in the same color and pattern is great for making shawls!
