

## Double Twill



Size 7 needles. Acrylic worsted (#4) yarn – works well with Caron One Pound solid colors.

Finished size should be 7" wide x 9" tall.

Cast on 32 stitches (multiple of 4). Be sure to leave an 18" tail at the beginning.

\*K1 P1\* repeat between \* to the end of the first seed stitch row.

\*P1 K1\* repeat between \* to the end of the second seed stitch row.

### **Pattern set:**

Row 1: P1 \*K2, P2\* – repeat between \* a total of 7 times. K2, P1

Row 2: K1 \*P2 K2\* – repeat between \* a total of 7 times. P2, K1

Rows 3 and 4: \*P2 K2\* repeat 8 times

Row 5: K1 \*P2 K2\* – repeat between \* a total of 7 times. P2, K1

Row 6: P1 \*K2, P2\* – repeat between \* a total of 7 times. K2, P1

Rows 7 and 8: \*K2 P2\* repeat 8 times

STOP! Check the width to make sure it is 7". If not, change needle size to get the appropriate width or add or subtract multiples of 4 stitches.

Repeat rows 1-8 for ~7 complete pattern sets.

STOP! Check the length to make sure it will not exceed 9". Adjust the final length by reducing the number of complete pattern sets. Bind off in an even row.

Instead of starting an additional pattern set, a pair of seed stitch rows (binding off in the last row) can be added at the end of the block by repeating the two seed stitch rows given above.

Be sure to leave an 18" tail at the end.

Now, knit another one using this or a different pattern since having two blocks in the same color is great for making shawls!

**Knitting abbreviations:**

K: Knit | P: Purl
