

Peace Dove



Size 7 needles. Acrylic worsted (#4) yarn – works well with Caron One Pound solid colors.

Finished size should be 7" wide x 9" tall.

Cast on 31 stitches in main color. Be sure to leave an 18" tail at the beginning.

Rows 1 & 2 (seed stitch): K1 *P1 K1* repeat between * to end

Odd rows 3-11 (right side): K1, P1, K27, P1, K1

Even rows 4-12 (wrong side): K1, P29, K1

STOP after 6 rows! Check the width to make sure it is 7". If the block is too wide, try using smaller needles or eliminate two stitches which will be stitches 1 and 31 of the pattern. If the block is too narrow, add pairs of stitches, one to each side of the pattern. Maintain the seed stitch edges with any added stitches. An alternative approach would be to use smaller or larger needles with 31 stitches.

Follow the chart for rows 13-42 with:

- for the main color

● for the contrasting color

◆ for an additional contrasting color (if used) or use the same contrasting color

The right-facing dove was created by following the italicized stitch numbers that run left to right. The left-facing dove was created by following the stitch numbers that run right to left. Odd-numbered rows are right side and are knit except that stitches 2 and 29 are purls. Even-numbered rows are wrong side and are purl except that stitches 1 and 31 are knit.

After completing the pattern, repeat rows 3-10 (stockinette) then rows 1 and 2 (seed stitch), binding off in the second seed stitch row. Be sure to measure the block often and add or decrease stockinette rows so that the final length of the block will be 9”.

Be sure to leave an 18” tail at the end.
