## Snowdrop Baby Beanie



This pretty beanie is worked flat and seamed at the back. The pattern includes five sizes, to fit from newborn to about 3 years old, and the simple design is a good introduction to a lacy pattern. I used an easy care, acrylic yarn, but as long as the tension matches you can use any yarn you like.

### Sizes (approx.)

0-3 months: 30cm (12") round, 13cm (5.25") high 3-6 months: 33cm (13") round, 13.5cm (5.5") high 6-12 months: 35cm (14") round, 14cm (5.75") high 1-2 years: 38cm (15") round, 15cm (6") high 2-3 years: 40cm (16") round, 15.5cm (6.25") high

\*\*\*As with all children's clothing, sizes can only be approximate. Remember to cast on very loosely so that the ribbing can stretch.\*\*\*

#### Tension

22 st and 28 rows to 10cm on 4mm needles

#### Materials

16-35g of double knitting acrylic1 pair 4mm needles1 tapestry needle



#### **Abbreviations**

k = knit
p = purl
st = stitch
yfd = yarn forward
k2tog = knit two stitches together
p2tog = purl two stitches together

#### Method

Cast on 63 [70, 77, 84, 91] sts

Row 1: \*k1, p1\* repeat from \* to \* to last st, k1 Row 2: \*p1, k1\* repeat from \* to \* to last st, p1

Rows 3-6: repeat rows 1-2 twice

Row 7: k1, make 1 by picking up loop from st on lower row, k to end (64 [71, 78, 85, 92] sts)

Row 8: p

Row 9: \*k3, then (yfd k2tog) twice\* repeat from \* to \* to last st, k1

Row 10 (and all subsequent wrong-side rows): p

Row 11: k1, \*k1, then (yfd k2tog) three times\* repeat from \* to \* to end

Row 13: as Row 9

Row 15: k

Row 17: k1, yfd k2tog, \*k5, yfd k2tog\* repeat from \* to \* last 5 sts, k5

Row 19: k4, yfd k2tog, \*k5, yfd k2tog\* repeat from \* to \* last 2 sts, k2

Continue in stocking stitch (k right-side rows, p wrong-side rows) until work measures a total of 9.5 [10, 10.5, 11.5, 12] cm, including the ribbing.

#### To shape the crown:

Row 1: \*k5, k2tog\* repeat from \* to \* to end of row, k1 (55 [61, 67, 73, 79] sts)

Row 3: \*k4, k2tog\* repeat from \* to \* to end of row, k1 (46 [51, 56, 61, 66] sts)

Row 5: \*k3, k2tog\* repeat from \* to \* to end of row, k1 (37 [41, 45, 49, 53] sts)

Row 7: \*k2, k2tog\* repeat from \* to \* to end of row, k1 (28 [31, 34, 37, 40] sts)

Row 9: \*k1, k2tog\* repeat from \* to \* to end of row, k1 (19 [21, 23, 25, 27] sts)

Row 11: k2tog to end of row, k1 (10 [11, 12, 13, 14] sts)

Biggest size only: Row 12: p2tog across row (7 sts).

Break yarn, leaving a long enough tail to thread through the remaining sts and sew seam from crown to bottom edge. Sewing through the outside loops with back stitch should result in a smooth seam.
